- Create an animal that combines different animal features.

- Make a diorama of a scene from your favorite book.
- Build a building with blocks or Legos.
- Free Choice.
- Take a virtual tour of a museum.
- Draw yourself as a super hero.
- Gather rocks, sticks, and leaves around your yard. Arrange them into a design or picture.
- Draw a picture outside with sidewalk chalk.
- Create a maze for someone to solve.
- Make a sock puppet.
- Create a cardboard puppet theater. Perform a puppet show.
- Watch a How to Draw video with a family member and follow along.
- Create a comic strip.
- Draw your favorite toy/possession from observation.
- Draw a portrait of someone in your family.
- Cut facial features (eyes, mouth, etc.) from a magazine/catalog then arrange into a funny face collage.
- Draw while listening to music.
- Draw a pet.
- Build a blanket fort and draw inside.
- Create a paper/cardboard sculpture.
- Tell a family member or friend about your artwork.
- Create a back-and-forth drawing. One person starts a drawing with a simple shape then passes it another person to add to, continue passing back and forth.
- Read a story. Create a new illustration for your favorite part.
